

NEVADA GIRLS STATE
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 6

AN ACT that will require all students attending public high schools and junior high schools in the state of Nevada to take at least 10 hours of sexual harrassment and sexual assault education and prevention throughout their time in school.

SECTION 1: Many young assaulters don't have bad intent but have not been properly taught what is okay and what is not okay.

SECTION 2: Several cases go unreported because victims don't understand that they are being violated allowing assaulters to continue their actions towards others without punishment.

SECTION 3: Pre-existing sexual assault classes are not required or specific so minimum hours are implemented to allow a more indepth education and allows for student discussion.

SECTION 4: Students will learn that everyone is impacted by sexual harrassment and sexual assault.

SECTION 5: The curriculum will be the same throughout all schools and will be comprehensive on the topics of sexual harrassment and sexual assault.

SECTION 6: Schools will also make resources available to students for reporting and receiving help if they are experiencing sexual harrassment and/or have been impacted by sexual assault.

SECTION 7: This ACT will be effective upon final passage.
